- One watercolor Palette, small white round with about 8 wells
- Two sheets Arches 140lb cold pressed watercolor paper, one sheet
- Cut into fourths, to make 4- 11 " x 15" pieces and one cut in half to make two pieces 15" x 22".
- Winsor Newton Cotman watercolors, 5ml tubes, one each Permanent Rose,
 Winsor Blue or Pthalo Blue, Aureolin or Cadmium Yellow medium shade
- One ½" flat synthetic watercolor brush
- One No. 6 or 8 round pointed synthetic watercolor brush
- One 1": flat synthetic watercolor brush
- Paper towels
- Two plastic containers for water, minimum 1 pint size
- Two HB hard lead pencil
- One kneaded eraser
- One ½" Styrofoam or smooth wood board 16" x 23" to tape paper to (¾" masking from Wal Mart works best.)
- One container of masking fluid.
- One No. 2 round Robert Simmons watercolor or acrylic brush, needs a fine point and be flexible.
